1. Tires: prices are subject to change without notice. Tires mounted to rims will be subject to a \$25.00 surcharge.
2. The 16 to 43 Waste Management Corporation does not accept vehicles.
3. Lightly contaminated soil is accepted by appointment only, and must meet MOE guidelines. Please call 306-246-0678 one week before desired delivery.
4. Agricultural grain bags are to be delivered rolled and tied. Any grain bags received loose will be rolled by 16 to 43 Waste Management Corporation staff and subject to a \$5.00 per roll fee in addition to the regular fee.
5. The allowance of discounts, waiving of fees, surcharging, etc. will be at the sole discretion of the 16 to 43 Waste Management Corporation employee who is on duty to receive the waste. Verbal or physical abuse of any of our employees will not be tolerated.
6. The rates and policies are set by the 16 to 43 Waste Management Corporation Member Municipalities and their Board of Directors, and are subject to change without notice.
7. All fees are subject to GST.
8. **Payment may be made by cash, cheque, Mastercard, Visa, or Debit Card.**

Important to Remember:

- Disposal of waste in the 16 to 43 Waste Management Corporation facility is subject to provincial regulations for operating a waste disposal ground.
- There will be a 100% surcharge applied for unsorted waste loads containing large quantities of recyclable materials (cardboard, clean metal, wood, shrubs, etc.) contaminated with garbage. The penalty rate is \$228.00 per tonne with a minimum charge of \$500.00.
- Attention Commercial Transporters: With the exception of agricultural plastics (grain bags), there will be a 50% surcharge on any materials received from sources outside the urban municipalities of Blaine Lake, Hafford, Radisson, Maymont and the rural municipality of Douglas, with the exception of commercial transporters which are sub-contracted by the 16 to 43 Waste Management Corporation.
- The 16 to 43 Waste Management Corporation reserves the right to ban any firm from bringing solid waste into this waste management facility if it is determined the firm continually brings in large quantities of recyclable material mixed with landfill waste for disposal. A large quantity of recyclable material is defined as that which constitutes at minimum 10% of the load brought to the waste management facility for disposal.
