

WHAT CAN I PUT IN THE RECYCLING BIN?



THINGS YOU **CAN** PUT IN RECYCLING BIN:

- Cardboard - including cartons, beer cases, cereal boxes. **Flatten everything!**
- Office paper, magazines, newspapers, egg cartons, flyers, brochures.
- Milk and juice cartons, phone books, shredded office paper (**please bag this**).
- Plastic grocery bags (please bag a bunch of them together).
- Pop bottles, detergent jugs, shampoo bottles, milk jugs, yogurt & margarine containers.
- Aluminum trays and foil, and aluminum beverage cans.
- Tin cans (please empty and rinse these!)

THINGS YOU **CANNOT** PUT IN YOUR **RECYCLING** BIN and must go into your **WASTE** BIN:

| -Plasticised or waxed paper | -Tissues, paper towels |
| -Glass jars and bottles | -Wood & building materials |

THINGS YOU **CANNOT** PUT INTO **ANY** BIN and should be taken to the 16 to 43 Waste Management Landfill and Recycling Facility for handling:

THINGS YOU **CAN** PUT IN THE WASTE CONTAINER:

- Household food wastes
- Waste paper towels, tissues and rags
- Diapers etc. (It would be great if you would flush feces down the toilet!)
- Styrofoam and plastic (“Saran”) wrap, etc.
- Glass jars and bottles
- Plasticised, waxed or laminated boxes and paper goods
- Kitty litter (yes, kitty litter - please don’t try to flush this down the toilet!)

THINGS YOU **CANNOT** PUT INTO YOUR WASTE CONTAINER

- **Any recyclables which should be in the RECYCLING bin!**

THINGS YOU **CANNOT** PUT INTO **ANY** BIN and which should be taken to the 16 to 43 Waste Management Landfill and Recycling Facility for handling:
